- Troubleshoot issues with plumbing, electrical systems, HVAC, maintenance equipment, etc and report repairs needed to Administration
- Operate maintenance and grounds equipment
- Manage and oversee maintenance and sanitation workers for the Fair and events
- Keep grounds and facilities neat, clean, and well-organized
- Respond to maintenance requests promptly and efficiently
- Collaborate with Event Manager to fulfill event setup and needs
- Prepare facilities for changing weather conditions
- Manage and facilitate winter storage program
- Manage the campground
- Proven ability and skills to develop and maintain strong vendor relationships while securing competitive bids
- Collaborate with Executive Director on budgeting for facilities needs
- Experienced in skid steer operation

- Proven experience as a Facilities Manager, Maintenance Worker, Handyman, or similar role.
